
# HOPE, HEART & HOME JOINS ARCHBISHOP WENSKI UNDER THE STARS!



#### June is National Reunification Month.

We celebrate the accomplishments and hard work of families who overcame difficulties, to reunify with their children. We recognize the vital role of other family members, social workers, foster parents, mentors, civilian review panelists, attorneys, Guardians ad Litem, and courts who help reunify, strengthen, and support families. We hope to inspire other parents that it is possible to address and resolve the issues that led to their separation and to reunify with their children.

Foster care is supposed to be a temporary situation, and the primary goal for children is reunification with their biological family. Yet, the exact path to that result is unclear, and reunification is a process. When the judge rules that way, there is much work from all parties leading up to the event. Although reunification days are a joyous occasion, the path to reunification takes work, commitment, and investment of time and resources not only by the parents but everyone involved with the case. It truly takes a village to bring families back together.

## Introduces Miami's CBC at June Monthly Meeting




HOPE. HEART & HOME welcomed Bryttany Stringer,


